Introduction	<p>The Department of Microbiology, Rajarshee Chhatrapati Shahu Maharaj Govt. Medical College, Kolhapur, was founded in 2000. The department, which is currently located in the Shenda park building, has over the years witnessed seminal progress.</p> <p>The department is actively involved in teaching, training and providing clinical diagnostic services to Chhatrapati Pramila Raje (CPR) General Hospital, Rural Hospitals and adjoining government health care facilities in the District.</p> <p>The courses offered by the department include U.G., and P.G. medical programs. Department faculty are also involved in teaching the Allied Health Science Courses like PG-DMLT and BPMT.</p> <p>DIAGNOSTIC FACILITY: We have a well-equipped Microbiology Laboratory having the different sections available for the investigations as per NMC Norms.</p> <p>Department caters to the diagnostic needs of CPR general Hospital, Kolhapur. The laboratory provides culture sensitivity for bacteria , culture for fungi, Mycobacteria. Serological tests including widal, RPR, ASO, RA, ELISA for Dengue and Chikungunya, parasitology investigations, CD4 cell count testing, molecular diagnostics. The laboratory is recognized as State Reference laboratory for HIV surveillance and diagnosis, and has HIV viral load estimation facility under MSACS and NACO. Our HIV, SRL and VLL are NABL accredited since 2021. We have BSL (Bio Safety Level) 2 Lab for COVID-19 testing since May 2020. Department is recognized as reference lab under IDSP and NVBDCP .</p> <p>Average per year investigations are more than 85000. So far 8,63,700 no of Covid-19 RTPCR tests have been performed by the molecular lab of this department which is the highest no amongst state govt medical college VRDL labs</p> <p>ADDITIONAL SERVICES PROVIDED:</p> <p>I) Hospital Infection Control program: Active contribution in Hospital Infection Control (HIC) program.
